I understand that Federal regulations under 49 CFR 1542.209 imposes a continuing obligation for me to disclose to the Springfield/Branson National Airport within 24 hours if I am convicted of any disqualifying criminal offense that occurs while I have unescorted access authority.

The information I have provided on this application is true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief and is provided in good faith. I understand that a knowing and willful false statement on this application can be punished by fine or imprisonment or both. (See Section 1001 of Title 18 United States Code.)



CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK (CHRC)

In accordance with the Transportation Security Administration TSAR Part 1542.209, a copy of the criminal record received from the FBI will be provided to an individual only if requested in writing. The Airport Security Coordinator will address any questions concerning the results of the criminal history records check (CHRC).

If an individual receives notice that a disqualifying crime was returned from their FBI criminal history records check, and the individual questions the validity of the criminal record, the individual must notify the Springfield/Branson National Airport within 30 days in writing of his or her intent to correct any information he or she believes to be inaccurate. If no notification is received from the individual, Springfield/Branson National Airport may make the final determination to deny unescorted access authority.
